Moving to the Hermitage releases, there's roughly 900 bottles of the 2013 Hermitage Blanc. Made from 100% Marsanne and all from the Greffieux lieu-dit (which is known for high quality whites), it's aged in 3-4 year old barrels. Ripe, textured, medium to full-bodied and borderline voluptuous, it gives up lots of buttered citrus, honeysuckle, white peach and mineral qualities. It should drink nicely no release, but evolve gracefully as well. Located in tiny cellar in downtown Tain l'Hermitage, Marc Sorrel makes classic, old-school red and whites that are almost overflowing with character.
