Deep, sweet and chewy, with strong tannins but excellent lingering sweetness. Component #2, from schist soil in Cote-Rozier: Spicier and more perfumed, with floral red and dark berry aromas. The sweet cherry and blackberry flavors are densely packed and focused. **91-94 points**

Utterly hypnotic heady bouquet of red and dark berry preserves, cherry-cola, violet, incense and minerals; this has to be one of the most alluring bouquets of any wine I tasted on this year's trip.
